REGULAR MEETING AMERICAN LEGION AUXILIARY POST 26 MAY 20, 2014

Department President Ann Crawford spoke. She reviewed the Department President projects and reminded us to say 'thank you' to our Veterans and to their family members who serve at home.

Judith Snyder, Area Coordinator of the Binky Patrol, reviewed the goals of the program. Binky Patrol donates homemade blankets to children from 0-18 years old who have experienced trauma in their lives. Judy became our 181st member.

Pop tabs are being collected to fill another box. \$51,000 in coupons has been sent.

Shirley read the names of the twenty people who helped with poppies on May 9 and 10 including two Girl Staters. Thank you to those who worked!
