- 11/05/1955 The stereo radio was introduced
- 11/06/1860 President Lincoln defeated three candidates for President of the U.S.
- 11/08/1793 The French museum, the "Louvre" was opened to the public

- 11/10/1782 The last battle of the American Revolutionary War was fought
- 11/12/1954 Ellis Island received its last immigrant
